Ladies & Gentlemen,

It has been brought to my attention that many CMHF players are not complying with Hockey Canada rule 24 – Protective Equipment during pre-game warm-ups.

All teams should be reminded that wearing a BNQ approved neck protector and properly fastened chin strap during pre-game warm-up is mandatory.

This can be an issue at the Bantam AAA and Midget AAA levels where the pre-game warm-up often takes place prior to the re-surfacing of the ice and therefore not monitored by on-ice officials.
